Return to Play Protocol

- Play a shortened version of the game T/20 Format
- The length of the season will be determined by the start date
- Only Teams registered in the league will be allowed to play.
- Registration is voluntarily. Standings at the end of 2019 season will be frozen for 2020 and will not affect any Team missing out this season.
- 5. All participants will be asked the following questions:
 - A) Have you travelled outside of Canada in the last 14 days?
 - B) Have you been in contact with anyone infected with CoVid-19?
 - C) Have you been experiencing any illness such as sore throat, dry cough, headaches, fever shortness of breath?
- Any player who has been out of the country will have to self-isolate for 14 days before being allowed to play
- 7. Each team comprises of 11 players

- On the field of play, there will be 11 players fielding, 2 batters batting at any given time and 2 umpires.
- Cricket is not a contact sport; Players can maintain 2 meters distance from each other.
- 10. Umpires will have to wear masks during matches
- 11. The MCA will provide adequate cleaning solutions and hand sanitizers in the cricket house at Assiniboine Park.
- 12. No ride sharing to park unless players live at the same address.
- 13. Anyone with flu like symptoms or fever is not allowed to play. Umpires have the authority to verify if a player shows any symptoms
- 14. Captains of both teams playing at a given field will <u>arrive 30 mins prior</u> to the start time to take the toss with at least one umpire present.to the field
- 15. After the match is over all teams are asked to leave the cricket area if another match is scheduled to start immediately.
- 16. Players are always asked to observe social distancing

Fielding Teams

- 1. The cricket ball must be sanitized regularly by the umpires
- 2. No fielder will come within six feet of the batters.
- 3. Players on the field will not touch each other in any fashion including celebrations at the fall of a wicket.
- 4. Players will maintain set distance of minimum **6 feet** from each other.
- Individual water bottles only, no refillable bottles with the big jug is allowed on ground
- Players must maintain 6-foot distance at water breaks.

- 7. Bowlers (Pitchers) are not allowed to use saliva to shine the ball.
- 8. All fielders will carry personal hand sanitizers and use it regularly while fielding.
- 9. No Spitting on the ball.
- 10. No spitting on your fingers when bowling
- 11. If any fielders need to communicate with the batsmen, they need to be at least 6 feet away.
- 12. No verbal confrontation with any batter or umpire is allowed as per MCA Code of Conduct
- 13. The Wicket Keeper (Back Stopper) will maintain 6 feet distance from the batter regardless of what bowler is bowling

Batting Teams

- 1. No sharing of batting gloves or helmets is permitted.
- 2. Batters will always maintain **6 feet** distance when communicating.
- 3. Batters will <u>never</u> handle the ball. The bat can be used to get the ball back to a fielder if it is on the pitch or stuck in the batsman pads
- 4. Batters will maintain 6 feet distance when communicating with fielders
- Players on the side lines must maintain 6 feet distance outside the boundary

Umpires

- Umpires must hand sanitize throughout the game at regular intervals
- b. Umpires will not share water battles with players
- c. Umpires have the right to question a player if he has a steady cough or show signs of not feeling well.
- d. Umpires are fully in control of game and will ensure all matches start and end in the given time frame.
