Purpose

- 1. The Manitoba Cricket Association is committed to creating a sport environment in which all individuals are treated with respect and dignity. Coaches have a responsibility to create a sporting environment that is free of harassment and abuse.
- 2. The Manitoba Cricket Association requires that all coaches participating in cricket <u>must</u> complete the online Respect in Sport as required by Sport Manitoba.

Scope and Application:

- 1. The policy applies to all coaches registered with; or named on an official sport roster; or under the jurisdiction of the Manitoba Cricket Association.
- 2. Any coach not having completed the program or maintained certified status in the timeframe established by The Manitoba Cricket Association may be removed as a coach until such time that the course is completed.
- 3. The Board of Directors of The Manitoba cricket Association is responsible for setting out the communication and timing of course completion and recertification.

Enforcement:

Non-compliance of this policy may result in further discipline as determined by the Board of Directors or in accordance with The Manitoba Cricket Association policy.
