MCA Team Registration and Naming Rights Policy

Purpose

1. The Organization recognizes the growth of the MCA membership and League and more teams will be registering with the MCA to participate. This Policy describes the procedure for teams to be registered, safeguards in place and the responsibility of individuals.

1. Ownership

- The individual, team, or club that registers with MCA and submits the official registration form is recognized as the legal owner of the registered team or club.
- All dues and financial obligations must be paid for this Club/team to be recognised as an official team and be given all privileges as outlined by the By Laws.

2. Bylaws and Constitution

- If a team or club has submitted written bylaws and a constitution of that team or club, those documents will govern its internal operations and structure.

3. Team Naming Rights

- If a single team is registered under an individual, the responsibility for the team's name rests solely with that individual.
- If a team is registered under a club, the club reserves the right to determine and approve the team's name.
- The MCA has guidelines for naming a team and must be followed.

4. Disputes

- In case of a dispute, MCA will rely on the data provided in the official registration form.
- Teams registered under a club must obtain approval from the club's managing committee/ Owner for any name change.
- MCA will not interfere in internal disputes within clubs or teams. MCA will only apply this policy and remain neutral in all internal matters of Clubs/Teams

5. Transfers of Ownership

- If a team or club is sold, purchased or acquired by another club or team, MCA will honor the terms of the written agreement provided by the involved Clubs/Teams and must be submitted electronically to MCA before the start of league.

6. Annual Documentation

- All clubs are encouraged to submit updated paperwork to MCA each year to prevent potential disputes.

7. New Registrations

- All new teams and clubs must submit a written new team registration form to MCA for official recognition and future reference.
